Carol shares her professional experience with students to encourage them to think globally as they make their way into the world of work. In her most recent college-level book, *Keys to Business Success*, she interviews new and seasoned professionals that give students perspective of the global market, the growing trend in entrepreneurship, and the importance of communicating professionally in a digital world.
